

- **CAUTION!**Do not leave the adaptors in a place where a child may step on them. A hit on the adaptor when plugged in the electricity may cause damage and serious risk of injury!
- If you use a wireless telephone, wireless video device, Wi-Fi network, microwave or Bluetooth devices at frequency of 2.4 GHz, and the video monitor units show interferences, relocate the baby unit at a larger distance until the interference disappears.
- Do not use spare parts or other components, which are not supplied by the manufacturer! The
 producer does not assume responsibility in case spare parts have been used which are different
 from the approved type or recommended by the producer.
- Do not make changes or modifications on the product! Do not modify the electric circuit and do
 not add other electrical parts! If necessary, contact the retailer or an authorized service center for

- Before plugging the adaptors in, check if the voltage marked on the adaptor is the same as the voltage of the local electricity network. If not, you will damage the product!
- · Do not use damaged adaptors.
- Do not remove the labels and warnings on the product! They are important for everyone who
 uses the product!
- Keep the nylon package away from children to avoid suffocation!

WARNINGS FOR USING BATTERIES

- Always secure the batteries compartment with the cover after you installed the batteries.
- · Do not allow children to have access to the batteries or play with them!
- Install batteries only with the needed size and voltage.
- · Do not use batteries with different size.
- Do not mix new and used batteries.
- · Obey the given polarity at batteries compartment.
- Remove damaged or dead batteries.
- · Remove the batteries when you are not going to use the product for a long period of time.
- · Remove the batteries from the product while you are using the adaptors.

- · Do not throw the batteries in open fire. Do not disassemble the batteries.
- CAUTION! When you stop using the product, do not dispose of it with normal house-hold waste but hand it over in an official waste collecting point. The waste formed from damaged electrical and video devices, batteries, adaptors, must be disposed of separately. Throwing them out in containers for household waste is forbidden.




ADVICES FOR BETTER RANGE AND OPERATION

FOR THE NIGHT

- For better operation and during longer period of usage, we recommend you to use adaptors, not batteries to supply both units.
- When the batteries are low, the LED indicator will light in orange/red.

- When the transmitter and receiver are located in long distance between each other, this could
 affect the connection quality and the receiver may not get signal from the transmitter. Then you
 will hear an alert to show you that units are out of range and indicators for ON/OFF will blink. It
 is recommended to cut the distance between both units.
- When the transmitter and receiver are located too close to each other, you will hear an acoustic sound. Distance both units or reduce the sound level of the receiver.
- If between both units there are many walls or sailings or you use wireless phone, wireless video, Wi-Fi net, micro oven or Bluetooth devices on frequency 2.4 GHz, the transmitter or receiver may get disorder. Place the parent unit somewhere else closer to baby unit or turn off other wireless devices.

INSTALLATION OF THE BATTERIES IN BOTH UNITS




Tools you need: a screwdriver.

- Remove the covers of the batteries compartment
- Install in each unit 3 pcs size AAA/ 1.5V batteries obeying the given polarity
- · Secure the batteries with the cover

IMPORTANT! Remove the batteries while you are using the adaptors to supply both units.

PAIRING THE UNITS



Units are paired in advance by the producer.

In case the connection between the units breaks down, pair the units as described below:

- 1) Turn on both units (ON/OFF button).
- Press simultaneously pairing buttons on both units. Indicators ON/OFF will start blinking until both devices pair successfully.
- 3) Release the buttons.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
Noise from receiver, when using batteries	Check the power indicator. If light is orange, batteries are exhausted. Insert new batteries.
Signal from transmitter stops suddenly	If the transmitter in baby's room doesn't detect noise from baby or other objects (radio, clock or TV) in the room, it stops transmitting signal to receiver. VOX function is activated. If any sound occurs in baby's room, receiver turns on automatically.
Weak signal	Make sure both devices are in operation range. If necessary, pair both units

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Do not step on the power supply cable and keep it from twisting especially around the connectors, socket and the point where the cable comes out of the unit.
- Keep the units for the parent and baby and the adaptors so that they will have sufficient ventilation. Do not cover them with clothes, towels, covers, etc.
- Always unplug the units from the sockets whenever there is thunder or if you will not use them
 for a long time.
- Do not immerse the parent or baby units in water, do not wash them with running water.
- Clean the parts of the baby monitor and adaptors with a dry towel after you have turned the units
 off and unplugged the adaptors from the electricity network.
- · Store in a dry and cool place.
